Ten County Matmen Win Regional Crowns

York County wrestlers came away with 10 firsts and seven seconds in the Regional Middle Atlantic AAU Junior Olympic Wrestling Tournament held at Newport High School.

The 17 wrestlers will compete in the Middle Atlantic AAU finals Saturday at Franklin and Marshall College. West York tops the list with seven while Hanover and Dover each have four representatives. York County also added 10 third-place finishers and five fourth places.

Champions in the Bantam Division (8 and under) were Dover's Kevin Bricker (50) and Jay Egloff of Hanover (heavyweight). Troy Ketterman of West York placed second in the 60-pound class.

In the Midget Division (9 and 10) Dover's Shaun Smith stopped West York's Todd Neff in the 85-pound matchup. Heavyweight Tony Koontz of Hanover earned the title of champion while Central's Greg Sargen was second

in the 90-pound class.

In the junior division, (11-12) three West Yorkers finished first. They were Dave Toggas (90), Alan Silar (100) and Glen Reger (heavyweight). Another Bulldog, Rusty Peters (168) placed second.

York County notched three championships in the Intermediate Division (13 and 14). In the 80-pound class, West York's Joel Pugh placed first while Dallastown's John Contino topped the 90-pound competitors. Hanover's Andy Kuhn (110) also notched a first. Second places went to Dover's Eric Shaffer (85), Dover's Kevin Mummert (95) and Hanover's Rob Roscoe (126).

Third places went to Steve Frey, Mark Egloff, Eugene Gobrecht, Roger Gay, Scott Zeigler, Karl McCleary, Brad Strebis, David Tracy, Brent Seitz and Dave Shellenman. Finishing fourth were Jay Clayton, Mike Einsig, Tom Toggas, Roger Rebert and Dave Posey.
